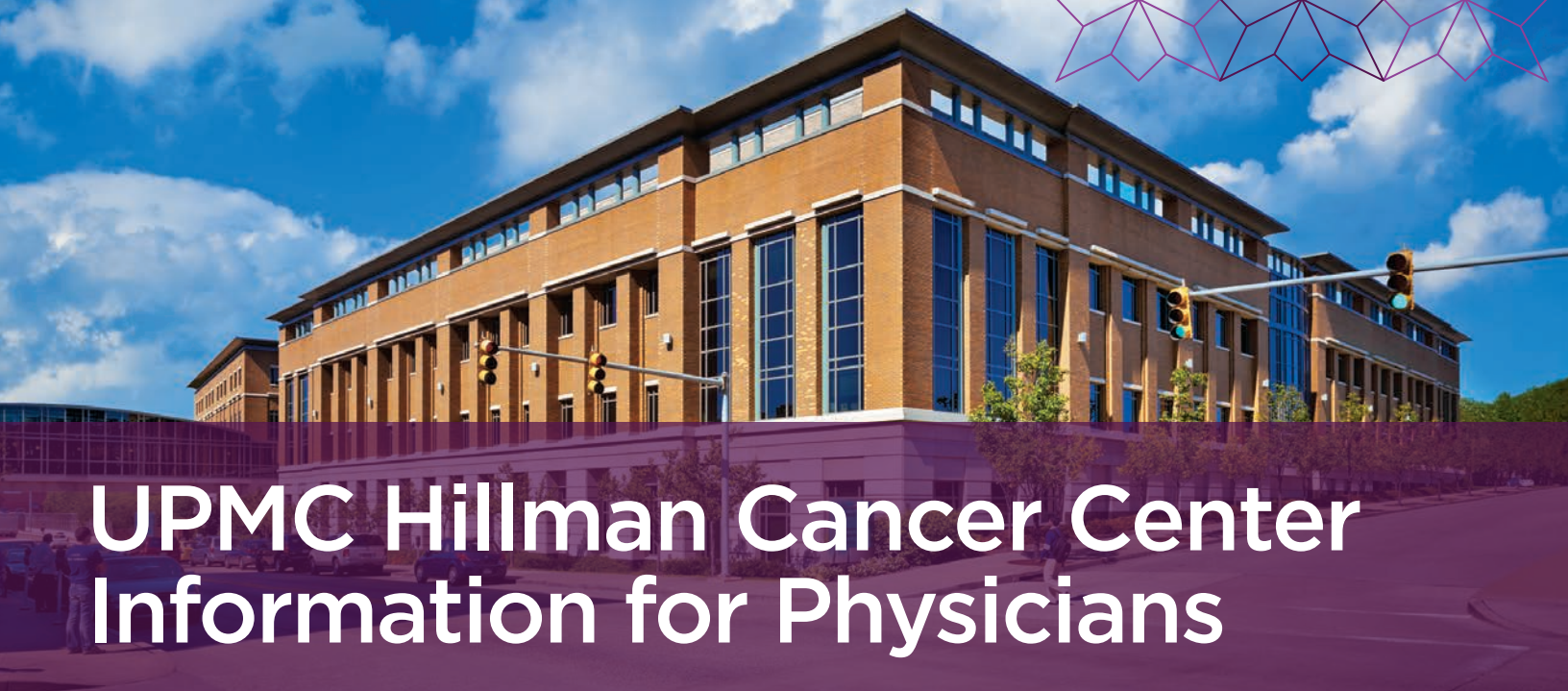

UPMC Hillman Cancer Center Information for Physicians

UPMC Hillman Cancer Center is internationally recognized for its leadership in the prevention, detection, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer. As a preeminent institution for the delivery of cancer care, the performance of basic, translational, and clinical research, and the education of the next generation of cancer researchers and physicians, UPMC Hillman is exceptionally well positioned to contribute to the global effort to reduce the burden of cancer.

A Proud History, a Bright Future

Ronald B. Herberman, MD, noted cancer physician and researcher, founded the University of Pittsburgh Cancer Institute (UPCI) in 1985. UPCI and UPMC's clinical oncology services collaborated from the very beginning to explore new and better ways to understand, diagnose, treat, and prevent cancer. In 2002, Hillman Cancer Center opened in Shadyside thanks to generous support from the late philanthropists Henry and Elsie Hillman. That facility anchored the clinical and research efforts of the UPMC CancerCenters network and UPCI, hosting clinical facilities and research laboratories under one roof.

In 2017, UPMC united its clinical oncology services and cancer research programs under the name of UPMC Hillman Cancer Center to better reflect the availability of world-class care at each location. Today, UPMC Hillman is a network of more than 70 domestic and six international clinical care sites, seven research programs, and more than 2,000 physicians, researchers, and staff all united in the pursuit of one goal: to bring together compassionate care and transformative research to achieve the extraordinary – life without cancer.

NATIONAL CANCER INSTITUTE

UPMC Hillman is one of only 57 National Cancer Institute (NCI)-designated Comprehensive Cancer Centers in the United States, one of just three in Pennsylvania, and the only one in western Pennsylvania. The NCI extends its Comprehensive Cancer Center designation to an elite group of cancer centers for their demonstrated excellence in cancer research across multiple branches of science. UPMC Hillman has been an NCI-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center since 1990 and undergoes a rigorous and intensive evaluation of our research programs and related activities every five to seven years.

At UPMC Hillman we know that patients thrive when they receive care close to home, with family and community support. While many people may think of UPMC Hillman as a building in Pittsburgh’s Shadyside neighborhood, our world-class cancer center is far more than any single location.

UPMC Hillman’s clinical network extends throughout Pennsylvania, Ohio, New York, and Maryland to our international locations in Ireland, Italy, and Croatia, with a presence in UPMC hospitals, community partner hospitals, outpatient medical centers, and freestanding clinics.

UPMC Hillman’s flagship location in Shadyside brings outpatient care and cutting-edge cancer research together under one roof—but our research efforts transcend this single location as well. Nearly 400 clinical trials are available throughout the UPMC Hillman network, with physicians and scientists collaborating daily to better understand, diagnose, and treat cancer.

UPMC Hillman is the original developer of Elsevier ClinicalPath (formerly known as Via Oncology, now a separate company), a unique web-based technology that provides physicians with evidence-based clinical algorithms that standardize best-practice treatments to optimize patient outcomes. UPMC Hillman physicians utilize ClinicalPath throughout the network to ensure that a patient who is treated at any UPMC Hillman facility receives the same comprehensive, evidence-based care that is best for their diagnosis.

Our experts provide comprehensive care for patients with difficult or rare cancers and second opinions on the most challenging cases through our Specialty Care Centers (SCCs). Organized by disease type, our SCCs engage a multidisciplinary team to expedite diagnosis and get patients into treatment as quickly and efficiently as possible. We offer SCCs for:

UPMC Hillman Cancer Center Services

UPMC Hillman offers comprehensive medical, radiation, and surgical oncology services, as well as supportive services to address symptom management and the various physical, emotional, and financial aspects of cancer care.

Harnessing the Body’s Own Potential: Medical Oncology and Immunotherapy

At UPMC Hillman, more than 150 medical oncologists utilize medically based therapies to treat a range of cancers. We conduct ongoing research to develop new and better therapies, lessen side effects, and provide more hope to patients.

Our medical oncology services include:

- Chemotherapy
- Immunoglobulins
- Immunotherapy
- Iron infusions
- Hormone therapy
- Targeted therapy

Immunotherapies, which modify a patient’s own immune system or immune cells to fight cancer, have become a hallmark of cancer treatment for many patients. Accredited by the Foundation for the Accreditation of Cellular Therapies (FACT), UPMC Hillman has a long history of the utilization of immunotherapies for cancer and currently employs immunotherapeutic strategies whenever possible.

Program Highlights



- **The Mario Lemieux Center for Blood Cancers** at UPMC Hillman in Shadyside was the first in western Pennsylvania to offer FDA-approved chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T-cell therapy for certain types of blood cancers in 2018. Our program offers treatment for patients with select diagnoses in lymphoma, leukemia, and multiple myeloma and has delivered more than 300 FDA-approved CAR T-cell therapy treatments to date.
- UPMC Hillman’s **Melanoma Program** was first recognized as one of the nation’s best in 2008 and has gained recognition for pioneering work with biological treatments and immunotherapies, changing the standard of care for melanoma patients.
- **The Immunotherapy and Drug Development Center** (IDDC), established in 2022, combines the Cancer Immunotherapeutic Center and Phase I Clinical Trials Center. The IDDC is committed to quickly moving the most promising research results from labs into clinical trials, providing early access to new and innovative cancer treatments.



Delivering Precision: Radiation Oncology

UPMC Hillman’s board-certified radiation oncologists and medical physicists work in collaboration with referring physicians and multidisciplinary specialists across the entire spectrum of health care to provide safe, effective radiation therapies based on the latest medical evidence using state-of-the-art imaging technology and radiation delivery systems.



The American College of Radiation Oncology (ACRO) accredits our radiation oncology program, recognizing our compliance with strict, national standards for cancer patient safety and radiation oncology practices. UPMC Hillman is the largest ACRO-accredited system in the nation.

Program Highlights

- UPMC Hillman’s affiliation with the **University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine** enables us to offer comprehensive medical education programs, including our radiation oncology residency and training program and medical physics residency program, as well as advanced training on stereotactic radiosurgery and stereotactic body radiotherapy systems.
- Several of our physicians were heavily involved in an **American Association of Physicists in Medicine (AAPM)** working group to model dose effects from hypofractionated treatment. The outcome of this effort, which recently published in the *Journal of Radiation Oncology Biology Physics*, provides practice-changing guidance for SRS and SBRT.
- UPMC Hillman was one of the first in the world to install the **RefleXion X1**, which integrates PET imaging with radiation therapy using biologically guided markers, known as biology-guided radiation therapy (BgRT), to treat patients with stage IV metastatic cancers. Multiple tumors will be treated at once, providing options for patients who typically did not have viable therapeutic options.



Beyond the Cutting Edge: Surgical Oncology

UPMC Hillman harnesses the expertise of board-certified, fellowship-trained surgeons to deliver the most advanced surgical care for all types of cancers. UPMC Hillman’s surgeons are renowned for their experience in minimally invasive and robotic surgery techniques, which allow for smaller incisions, less blood loss, fewer complications, and a shorter hospital stay following surgery.

Our surgeons collaborate with medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, and other specialists and primary care physicians to ensure seamless care and ample communication.

Program Highlights

- For more than 25 years, our surgeons have utilized minimally invasive techniques for brain surgeries, including **Endoscopic Endonasal Approach (EEA)**, which removes tumors through the nose without incisions to the face or skull, and **Neuroendoport®** surgery, which uses a tube, or port, that allows doctors to access deep-seated tumors through a smaller opening in the lining of the brain than would be used in traditional brain surgery.
- The surgeons in our **Head and Neck Cancer Program** utilize **transoral robotic surgery** and other minimally invasive techniques to improve outcomes and minimize the impact on essential functions like breathing and swallowing.
- UPMC Hillman has **one of the world’s busiest gastrointestinal surgical oncology programs**, having performed more than 900 robotic Whipple procedures, more than 1,500 robotic pancreatic operations, more than 1,400 laparoscopic liver procedures, and more than 2,100 CRS/HIPEC procedures.

Caring for the Whole Patient: Supportive Services

Because cancer treatment affects a person’s entire life, UPMC Hillman provides a range of services to help patients and their families navigate the physical, emotional, financial, and logistical aspects of cancer care. Our supportive services include:

Program Highlights

- UPMC Hillman’s **Wellness and Integrative Oncology Program** uses movement, touch, nutrition, and mindfulness within conventional cancer care to address and improve symptoms and quality of life.
- The **UPMC Moving Through Cancer Program** aims to help patients get and stay active before, during, and after treatment. Cancer exercise specialists work with patients of all fitness levels and abilities to develop individualized plans for activity that can help reduce symptoms and side effects.
- Our **Caring for the Caregiver** series, hosted by the Wellness and Integrative Oncology Program, is an educational series for caregivers that focuses on self-care, mindfulness, stress management, and the other physical and emotional aspects of providing care to a loved one in their cancer journey.

Exploring What is Possible:
Research and Clinical Trials

UPMC Hillman encompasses seven specific Cancer Center Support Grant (CCSG)-supported research programs right here in Pittsburgh, including cancer biology, cancer immunology and immunotherapy, cancer virology, biobehavioral cancer control, cancer epidemiology and prevention, cancer therapeutics, and genome stability. Additionally, Hillman operates 10 CCSG-supported shared resources that provide services to our investigators.

The NCI established Specialized Programs of Research Excellence (SPOREs) to accelerate the movement of basic scientific findings into clinical care and to explore the biological basis for cancer in those who have been diagnosed or are determined to be at risk. UPMC Hillman’s SPOREs include:

- Head and Neck Cancer
- Melanoma and Skin Cancer



Clinical trials play a crucial role in cancer treatment, and UPMC Hillman currently offers nearly 400 trials throughout our footprint. In many cases, patients can enroll and participate in clinical trials right in their own communities, reducing the need to travel to Pittsburgh.

Research Highlights

- UPMC Hillman, then known as the University of Pittsburgh Cancer Institute, **was the first to develop activated natural killer cells** to treat cancer in 1987. Our founder Dr. Ron Herberman discovered the **natural killer cell**, which is key to fighting cancer within our bodies.
- UPMC Hillman was the first in the United States to create and test a **synthetic vaccine** (MUC-1) against cancer in 1993.
- UPMC Hillman researchers Drs. Patrick Moore and Yuan Chang have discovered **two of the seven** known cancer-causing viruses.
- UPMC Hillman expanded its **Immunologic Monitoring and Cellular Products Laboratory** (IMCPL) to permit FDA-cleared investigational therapies in 2021. This expansion tripled our capacity to make CAR T cells, adoptive tumor-infiltrating lymphocyte (TIL) therapies, oncolytic viral therapies, and other cancer treatments without having to send patient cells across the country to be made, modified, or grown. This allows for personalized cellular therapies, all manufactured right here in Pittsburgh. It is the largest facility of its kind west of Philadelphia, and its origins go back 30 years.

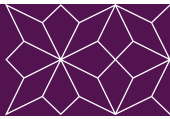
