

# IMPORTANT THINGS TO CONSIDER BEFORE COMPLETING VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

### **Commitment**

- Have I considered my schedule for the next 12 months?
- Am I able to realistically commit to volunteering for a weekly shift for a year?
- Along with my important work, school, and family obligations, will I be able to regularly volunteer at Children's and not be calling off due to a lot of conflicts?

# **Hospital Environment**

- Am I comfortable volunteering in an environment and interacting with sick infants, children, and teens from a variety of backgrounds with various illnesses, some of which may be life-threatening or terminal diagnoses?
- Am I comfortable interacting with family members of children, respecting boundaries, maintaining confidentiality, and offering support free of judgment, religious undertones, or overly personal in nature?
- Am I willing to visit and interact with children who are under isolation status (I will be provided with infection prevention training and all proper materials for maintaining a safe environment for the patient and myself)?

# **Volunteer Assignments**

- Would I be accepting that part of my regular volunteer experience includes wiping down and sanitizing toys and equipment to help maintain infection prevention standards and keep kids safe?
- Can I indicate my preferences for the type of volunteer experience that I am seeking but remain flexible to complete tasks that benefit patients and families upon request as needed?

#### **Regulatory Requirements**

- Am I willing to complete an initial orientation and ongoing regular training as requested within the established timeframe?
- Am I willing to submit the information required for securing the appropriate background clearances?
- Am I willing to receive a TB test both initially and on an annual basis and share results with the volunteer office?

### **Personal Motivations to Volunteer**

If any of the following statements pertain to you, we ask that you reconsider applying to be a volunteer with Children's Hospital at this time.

- Within the last year I have experienced the loss of a significant loved one.
- I am seeking a clinical experience in my volunteer role, either by shadowing a particular physician or staff member or gaining a clinical skill set for my education.
- I am interested in finding a job at Children's and view volunteering as a stepping stone to secure
  employment.
- I view volunteering as a way to spread my own personal or religious beliefs to others.
- I am looking for a short-term volunteer experience because I am unemployed, on break from school or work, or need community service hours to fulfill a mandated obligation.
