Ian, 6 months out from initial brain injry In August of 2019, Ian was diagnosed with a pilocytic astrocytoma and required surgical resection and subsequent chemotherapy. Ian and his family were engaged in the CIRCLE program in September of 2022, after he was admitted to the PICU with complications related to his tumor. Ian spent approximately 4 weeks in the PICU and another 6 weeks at inpatient rehabilitation recovering. He is now home with his family and continually improving. Ian recently joined cub scouts and is back to enjoying his favorite foods.

Post-intensive care syndromepediatrics (PICS-p) is the collective term for new impairments in emotional, cognitive, physical, and family health following admission to a pediatric ICU.

Signs of PICS-p:

- School difficulties
- Breathing issues
- Behavior regression
- PTSD
- Feeding difficulties
- Trouble sleeping
- Poor concentration
- Anxiety
- Sad or withdrawn
- Clumsiness/weakness
