


In simple terms, tell the child why she is at the hospital. Use staff as a resource to help explain the process to the child.





THE MRI MACHINE USES A REALLY STRONG MAGNET TO TAKE YOUR PICTURES.




DO YOU KNOW WHAT A MAGNET IS?

Feel free to discuss magnets at this time. Patients or anyone present during the test will need to be screened for metal.




Comfort items that do not contain metal, such as blankets or stuffed animals may accompany the child during the test. Be sure to check items with the staff. THIS IS HOW YOU WILL LOOK WHEN YOU LAY ON THE TABLE.



Tips for the adult

Assure the child that the staff is here to help.

BEFORE THE MRI MACHINE CAN TAKE YOUR PICTURE, YOU WILL HAVE TO PUT ON A SPECIAL SPACE SEAT BELT SO YOU ARE SAFE!

What helps your child relax? Singing a favorite song? Taking slow, deep breaths? Holding a stuffed animal?






