## Scholar Spotlight

### **Carolina Pinzon-Guzman, MD, PhD**

Born in Colombia, South America, Dr. Carolina Pinzon-Guzman began her journey in the United States after completing high school. She earned her undergraduate degree in Biomedical Science from Texas A&M University and went on to conduct full-time cancer biology research at the University of Pennsylvania. She was later accepted into the MD/PhD program at Penn State College of Medicine, where she completed her doctoral research in developmental biology, focusing on the genetic and molecular mechanisms of stem cell differentiation. Following graduation, Dr. Pinzon-Guzman pursued general surgery residency at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, where she took two dedicated years of postdoctoral research to investigate foregut development and its relationship to esophageal atresia. She continued this work during her fellowship at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Fetal Center, where she expanded her research into lung development in the context of congenital diaphragmatic hernia.



After completing pediatric surgery fellowship at the Montreal Children's Hospital, Dr. Pinzon-Guzman joined UPMC Children's Hospital as a pediatric surgeon-scientist. Her research continues to focus on the molecular and genetic foundation of foregut development, aiming to better understand and ultimately improve care for conditions such as esophageal atresia and congenital diaphragmatic hernia. She is also excited to collaborate with the UPMC Fetal Center to advance both clinical and scientific efforts in these areas.



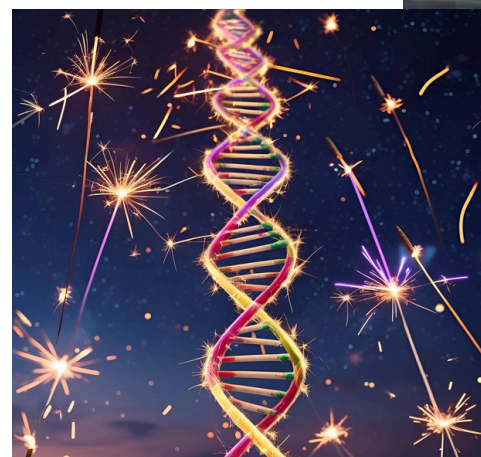
## Celebrating Our Newest Mellon Scholar Alumni!

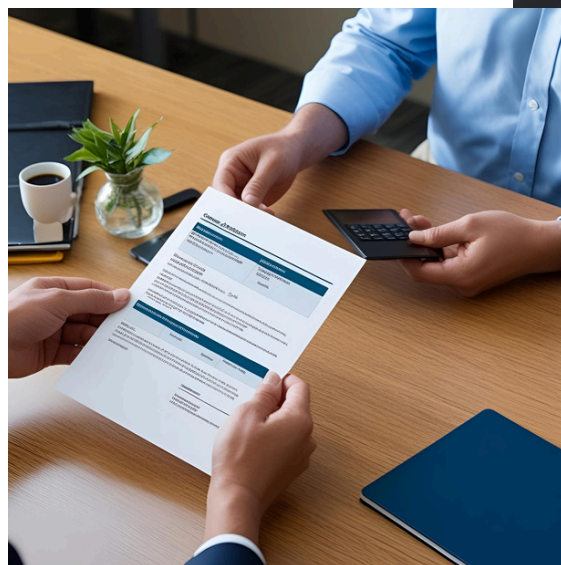

## Mock Study Section Grant Review Process

Mellon Scholars are encouraged to submit their complete grant applications (understandably perhaps in a very rough draft form) to administration via [email](#) roughly two months in advance of the appropriate funding deadline, along with a list of 3-5 potential Pitt reviewers. Reviewers may meet for discussions. The scholar will be provided with the written critiques from each reviewer and a summary of the discussion between the reviewers if one occurs. The scholar will be blinded to the identity of their reviewers. Discussion summaries and critiques will be returned to the scholar prior to the grant's agency due date, so that the scholar can incorporate any changes in response to these critiques.

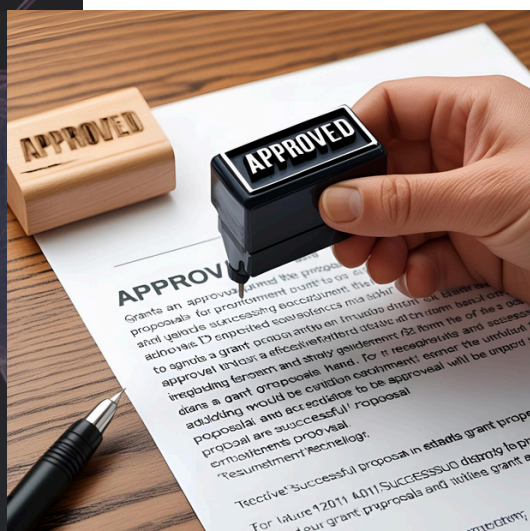

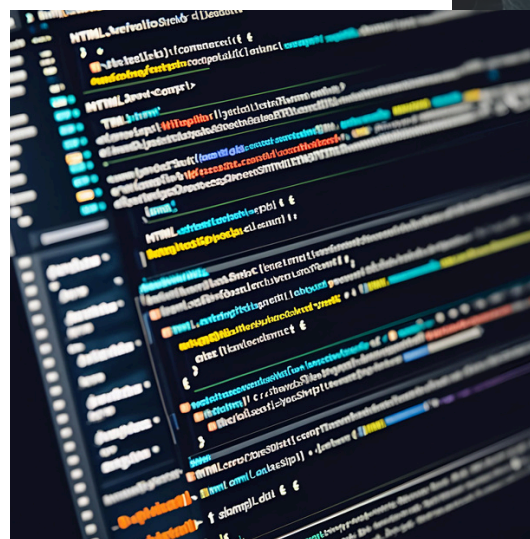
