Current Concepts in Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation

Saturday, May 4, 2019 Pittsburgh, PA

The care of persons with spinal cord injury (SCI) requires an interdisciplinary approach across the continuum of care. Through lectures and discussion, attendees will learn safe techniques to assist and teach transfers and wheelchair maintenance.

Understanding mechanics of gait training in appropriate patients and demonstrating effective strategies to perform activities of daily living helps to provide exceptional care to patients. A concrete knowledge of medical management of persons with SCI is an important foundation for good patient care. The annual Current Concepts in Spinal Cord Rehabilitation conference includes information about a variety of topics relevant to persons with SCI.

Sports Ultrasound Conference

Summer 2020 Pittsburgh, PA

The Sports Ultrasound Conference features both regional and international speakers, and is designed to expand knowledge and hands-on experiences for sports ultrasound. The conference agenda is comprised of both lecture and hands-on skill lab workshops, including cadaver workshops. Lecture topics include:

- · Hydro-dissection procedures
- Hydro-release
- Dynamic ultrasound evaluation of various sports injuries
- · Ultrasound-guided surgery
- Case presentations

Hands-on skill labs allow participants to put the information they learn during robust presentations into practice. The labs consist of both live model and cadaveric scanning opportunities. Applications of diagnostic and interventional ultrasound of all six major joints are applied.
