With a long-standing history of treating patients with lung disease, our team at UPMC cares for patients diagnosed with common to complex lung conditions, including:

- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)/emphysema
- Pulmonary fibrosis
- Cystic fibrosis and drug-resistant infections
- Primary pulmonary hypertension
- Sarcoidosis
- Alpha 1 anti-trypsin deficiency
- Bronchiectasis
- Secondary pulmonary hypertension (caused by lung or heart disease)
- Scleroderma



UPMC LUNG TRANSPLANT PROGRAM

Since the inception of the UPMC Lung Transplant Program in 1982, our surgeons have performed more than 2,350 lung and heart-lung transplants. We are one of only a few lung transplant centers in the United States that has achieved this volume while maintaining outcomes that are consistent with national averages. We have attained this level of success by working closely as a team with the UPMC Comprehensive Lung Center to provide exceptional care for patients along the entire spectrum of life-threatening lung diseases.





Our clinical experience, dedicated team, and resources have allowed our specialists to medically manage the most complex cases and have enabled us to offer innovative transplant options including:

- Sequential lung and bone marrow transplant for patients with underlying immunodeficiency disorders who have been declined for transplant at other centers due to increased risk of infection
- Lung transplant for systemic sclerosis and other rheumatologic diseases
- Lung transplant for cystic fibrosis and drug-resistant pathogens

We also do not have an age restriction for lung transplant referrals. Our experts have lung transplant experience with older adults and consider patients older than 70 on a case-by-case basis.

A Collaborative Approach

At UPMC, we provide the full scope of lung disease management and treatment. From diagnosis and disease management through the Comprehensive Lung Center, to expert transplant care at the Lung Transplant Program, to innovative research and education, we are all one cohesive team.

Our team also includes you – the referring physician. We will work with you and your team to ensure a seamless referral process and will collaborate with you to develop an individualized treatment plan that best fits the unique needs of your patient.
