LINKS IN THE CHAIN OF GENEROSITY — Amit Tevar, MD, surgical director, Kidney and Pancreas Transplant Program, Thomas E. Starzl Transplantation Institute, calls transplant surgery "the best job in the world." Dr. Tevar is inspired daily by donors' selfless acts.

SURGEONS PERFORM UPMC'S FIRST BLOODLESS HEART, KIDNEY TRANSPLANT — Clinicians performed a heart and kidney transplant without the use of blood products for the first time at UPMC Presbyterian. The patient is a Jehovah's Witness who, for religious reasons, does not accept blood products. This may be the first time a heart-kidney transplant has been performed in a patient who could not accept a blood transfusion.
