SUMMARY

- UPMC thriving as the region's most preferred provider and most preferred insurer, best serving the needs of patients, members and businesses
 - Patients seeking UPMC's top-ranked care driving **increased volumes** across clinical areas
 - The largest medical insurer in western PA totaling **more than 3.7 million members**, with among the lowest-cost products in the nation
- Substantial reinvestment in the region and beyond
 - **\$971 million** in capital spending and business investments to enhance quality and care
 - **\$1.2 billion** in IRS-defined charitable contributions and community benefits



Operations


- Operating income of *\$27 million* needed to run operations, fund capital expenditures and create new programs

 - Calendar year return for UPMC 13%




WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA'S HEALTH INSURANCE MARKET




- UPMC largest medical insurer in Western Pennsylvania

 - ✓ UPMC's individual plans remain among the lowest prices nationwide




SHIFTS IN INSURANCE MEMBERSHIP DIRECTLY IMPACTS DISCHARGES



% of Discharges, Western Pennsylvania






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ACCESS OF HIGHMARK MEMBERS TO UPMC PROVIDERS DRIVING GROWTH

Physician Service Revenue per Weekday



- Inpatient discharges at UPMC hospitals up 30%
 - ✓ At UPMC Passavant, discharges up 36%; surgical volumes up 77%
- Outpatient physician visits up 26%
 - ✓ UPMC Hillman Cancer Center outpatient visits up 17%
- UPMC Magee-Womens trending for an additional 800-1,000 births in 2020
- Inpatient rehab up 20%
