

Our heart team approach includes specialists in inherited cardiac diseases, heart valve disease, advanced heart failure, electrophysiology, vascular and cardiac surgery, and more.

Our artificial heart program, which uses ventricular assist devices (VADs), is one of the most active in the U.S., offering patients a bridge to heart transplantation or, in some cases, the opportunity to heal without needing a transplant.




Leading **oncology care** gives more options to cancer patients.

UPMC Hillman Cancer Center is a leader in cancer immunotherapeutics, having recently expanded its TIL-related clinical trials to the exploration of new treatments for uveal melanoma and bile duct cancer. We were also the first center in western Pennsylvania to offer chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T-cell therapy, a type of immunotherapy that uses a patient's own genetically modified T cells to find and kill cancer cells.


UPMC is home to the largest academic neurosurgery department in the United States. With national and international recognition for minimally invasive neurosurgery and stroke research and treatment, our physicians are innovators in treating complex, life-threatening conditions of the brain and spine.

UPMC is a world leader in Endoscopic Endonasal Approach (EEA) brain surgery for hard-to-reach skull-base tumors. This allows surgeons to operate directly through the nose and sinuses without facial incisions or disfigurement. UPMC experts have performed EEA surgery more than 3,500 times.

UPMC has more than 30 years of experience with another minimally invasive brain procedure, Gamma Knife® radiosurgery, which we introduced to North America. UPMC remains the leading center in the nation, having performed more than 16,000 Gamma Knife procedures. UPMC was also the site of the first microvascular decompression, now the standard of care for severe cranial nerve disorders, and has treated more than 20,000 patients with trigeminal neuralgia.

Advanced lung disease develops in many patients with interstitial lung disease, COPD, cystic fibrosis, and pulmonary hypertension. Our specialists provide comprehensive services, including experimental therapies and timely access to lung transplant. Pulmonary hypertension, or high blood pressure in the blood vessels in the lungs, can lead to right heart failure and other complications. Our Comprehensive Pulmonary Hypertension Program offers a full range of treatment options, from cutting-edge therapies to our world-renowned lung transplant program.
