### THE CARE DELIVERY MODEL

The Care Delivery Model is one component of the PPM.

- 1. Describes how the delivery of nursing care actually takes place.
- 2. It is demonstrated in patient care assignments, IPOC's, and the involvement of the patient and/or family in this delivery.
- 3. Each unit can select what works best for their patient population.
- 4. Our care delivery model must comply with the PA State Nurses Practice Act.
