Written approval granted by employing physician, i.e., signature on application & Delineation of Clinical Functions. 2. Three (3) references providing evidence of acceptable clinical experience. 3. Completion of clinical interview with ophthalmic technician peer reviewer. 4. Provisional period of one (1) year is required. Written evaluation must be completed by the department director/supervisor in the respective area of practice at the end of the provisional period indicating that the LHP has demonstrated appropriate skills to carry out the clinical functions as stated. The provisional period may be extended for an additional one (1) year as deemed necessary by the appropriate Medical Staff Department. 5. Periodic review will be done every two (2) years. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Liability insurance as evidenced by the respective physician's coverage. 2. Agree to abide by appropriate written Bylaws. 3. Signed statement of overall responsibility by employing physician. 4. Satisfactory recommendation regarding ability to relate to others. 5.
