KNOWLEDGE	Successful Completion of an ACGME/AOA, accredited program
TRAINING	Physicians requesting privileges in Emergency Medicine must have completed an accredited residency program in either Emergency Medicine, Pediatrics, Medicine, Surgery, Family Medicine or be Board Certified in Emergency Medicine.
CERTIFICATION	Physicians requesting privileges in Emergency Medicine must have completed an accredited residency program in either Emergency Medicine, Pediatrics, Medicine, Surgery, Family Medicine or be Board Certified in Emergency Medicine. May be Board Eligible attaining Board Certification within five (5) years of completing residency
OTHER	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ All physicians requesting privileges must have current ACLS and ATLS certificates or their equivalent, as determined by the Chairman of the Department.▪ Privileges in Emergency Medicine require either ACLS certificate, ATLS certificate, or Board certification.
