At the time of re-credentialing, a physician shall have satisfactorily performed a minimum number of a given procedure within the preceding two years, and must be able to provide such documentation. If the physician is not able to document this number of procedures but believes he or she is qualified, they may demonstrate competency by performing the procedure to the satisfaction of another member of the department who is already credentialed and who will certify that this physician is competent for the procedures: Lumbar Puncture Thoracentesis Paracentesis Central Venous Catheter Placement Arterial Line Placement Bone Marrow Aspirate Flexible Sigmoidscopy
