Demonstration of the performance of at least 100 deliveries and 100 gynecologic surgical procedures in the past two years or successful completion of a hospital-affiliated formalized residency or clinical fellowship For Maternal and Fetal Medicine privileges- Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to subspecialty in maternal and fetal medicine by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology or the American Osteopathic Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology or hold diplomat status in maternal and fetal medicine from the American Osteopathic Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology For Gynecologic oncology privileges- Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to subspecialty in gynecologic oncology by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Those physicians without approved training in gynecologic oncology must provide evidence of significant postgraduate continuing medical education in gynecology oncology and significant recent gynecologic oncological surgery experience. For Reproductive Endocrinology privileges- Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to subspecialty certification in reproductive endocrinology by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology or hold diplomat status in reproductive endocrinology from the American Osteopathic Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology

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For the special privileges listed below, the applicant must demonstrate successful completion of an approved and recognized course or acceptable supervised training in residency, fellowship, or other acceptable experience; and provide documentation of competence in performing that procedure. To demonstrate competence, proctored cases will be required by a credentialed physician.

Laparoscopy-pelviscopy with extensive adhesiolysis, ovarian cystectomy, salpingostomy, salpingectomy- 5 cases proctored by a credentialed physician designated by the Chairmen.

Operative Hysteroscopy- 5 cases proctored by a credentialed physician designated by the chairmen

Microsurgery as related to fertility- 5 cases proctored by a credentialed physician designated by the chairmen

Laser surgery of the lower genital tract- 5 cases proctored by a credentialed physician designated by the Chairmen

Laparoscopic assisted vaginal hysterectomy (LAVH)- 5 cases proctored by a credentialed physician designated by the Chairmen.

Intra-abdominal pelvic laser surgery- 5 cases proctored by a credentialed physician designated by the Chairmen
