<b>KNOWLEDGE</b>	Successful Completion of an ACGME/AOA, accredited program
<b>TRAINING</b>	The successful completion of an approved (ACGME/AOA) post graduate residency program in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation
<b>CERTIFICATION</b>	Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to certification in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation by the American Board of Physical Medicine or the American Osteopathic Board of Rehabilitation Medicine, or a similar certification process acceptable to the Hospital or as determined by the Chair of the Department.
<b>OTHER</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Demonstration of the provision of inpatient or consultative services for at least 50 physical and rehabilitative medicine patients during the past two years</li> </ul> <p><b><u>FLUOROSCOPY</u></b></p> <p><b>Initial Privileges</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Review the educational materials contained in a didactic manual, “Minimizing Risks from Fluoroscopic X-Rays” by Louis Wagner &amp; Benjamin Archer.</li> <li>2. Successfully complete a written test (passing grade of 80%). Up to 2.5 Category 1 CME credits will be awarded for a passing score.</li> <li>3.
