OTHER	<p>The granting of privileges in Radiation Oncology shall be based upon verified information using, but not limited to, the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Current medical license in the Commonwealth of PA; ▪ Federal and, where applicable, state registration to dispense narcotics; ▪ Demonstrated clinical competence; ▪ Review of quality assurance and risk management findings; ▪ References and recommendations from credible findings; ▪ No adverse findings report from the NPDB; ▪ Proof of current professional malpractice coverage
