This is an 18-bed medical telemetry unit providing specialized care to oncology patients and, in five special suites, palliative care patients.

Nurses are trained and certified to administer chemotherapy and provide care to patients who may require telemetry monitoring, neutropenic precautions, and more.

Each plan of care for patients is tailored to meet their unique care needs.
