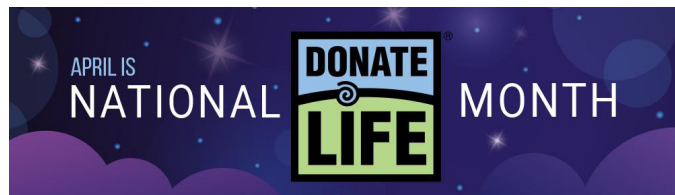


New student lounge
