What To Expect

The SNI Program is a 10-week, paid summer internship for student nurses who have completed their junior year or equivalent. You'll work 36-40 hours a week on a unit in one of a variety of clinical settings. Becoming a student nurse intern could be the beginning of a rewarding career at UPMC!
