



This guide provides directions, parking, and important information for the support person when a patient is transferring to UPMC Altoona. It is especially helpful for transfers during the evening or nighttime hours.

The patient is assigned to bed or location:



Driving Directions

From I-99 North or I-99 South

- Take Exit 33 to 17th Street.
- Turn right onto 6th Avenue.
- Turn left onto 7th Street.
 - Continue straight through all lights to get to the parking garage/Main Entrance.
 - Keep right after the final light to get to the Emergency Department Entrance.

Parking

The parking garage is the main parking location for patients and visitors. The first 30 minutes are free, and after that, the costs are as follows:

<u>1 hour</u>-\$2 <u>2 hours</u>-\$3 <u>3 hours</u>-\$4 <u>4+ hours</u>-\$6

Prices are subject to change. Parking pay stations are located on the Yellow and Red levels of the parking garage and on the 7th floor of the Outpatient Center.

There are also multiple parking lots surrounding the hospital where patients and visitors can park for free.

Valet Parking

Valet parking service is available for patients and support persons near the Main Entrance on weekdays from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and at the Emergency Department Entrance on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Valet parking for Emergency Department patients is free and \$7 for all others (cash only, pay at valet stand before parking). Prices are subject to change.

Electric Car Charging Station

There is 1 dual-port charging station reserved for electric cars on the top level of the parking garage. The cost to use the charging station is \$2 per hour for the first 4 hours and \$5 per hour for hours 5, 6, and 7. A \$50 charge will be added after 7 hours. Prices are subject to change.

Cafeteria

The cafeteria is located on the 4th floor of the Hospital Tower (across from the Main Visitor Elevators). Please ask a member of your care team for current hours.

Atrium Deli

The Atrium Deli is located in the Outpatient Center (Main Lobby) on the 1st floor. It offers Starbucks® coffee, sandwiches, salads, fresh soups, paninis, and grab-and-go foods. Please call **814-889-2351** or ask a care team member for the current hours.

Wi-Fi

We offer free wireless Internet access for all patients and support persons.

- 1. Go to "Wi-Fi" or "Network Connections" on your laptop or mobile device.
- 2. Choose "upmc-guest" to connect.
- 3. Once the Captive Wi-Fi screen appears, scroll down and press "**Log In**" to verify that you have read and accepted the Guest Internet Access Terms and Conditions.
