- Three intensive care units are housed inside the critical care tower, providing advanced care and specialty services.
- UPMC Hamot is the only certified comprehensive stroke center in northwest Pennsylvania. Our experts provide the only local access to interventional stroke treatments.
- UPMC Hamot is the region's first Comprehensive Cardiac Care Center certification.
- UPMC Magee-Womens, located on UPMC Hamot's campus, addresses the health care needs of women and infants. The facility's Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit cares for the most fragile of newborns.
- UPMC Hillman Cancer Center provides Erie patients local access to breakthrough research and leading-edge treatments.
- Through its partnership with UPMC Children's, UPMC Hamot provides world-class inpatient and outpatient care for kids in the Erie area.

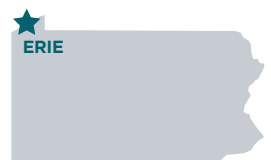
As the second largest employer in Erie County, UPMC Hamot is an economic pillar in the community.
