

A student must complete the following requirements to successfully meet the completion of the program, receive their certificate, and be eligible to take the registry test. The requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Maintain an academic average for each class of 78%.
- Maintain a clinical average of 78%.
- Demonstrate competency in 10 mandatory general patient care competencies, as listed in the ARRT clinical competency requirements.
- Demonstrate competency in all 36 mandatory radiological procedures, as listed in the ARRT clinical competency requirements. No more than 10 procedures may be simulated from the approved ARRT list.
- Demonstrate competency in at least 15 elective radiological procedures as listed in the ARRT clinical competency requirements. One of the 15 electives be selected from the head section. Two of the 15 electives must be selected from the fluoroscopy section.
- Must do a minimum of eight full PM shifts on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday evenings.
- Student must meet all financial obligations to the School of Radiography and the sponsoring institution.
- Complete all required coursework to program's satisfaction.
- Comply with all applicable standards as stated in their student handbook.
