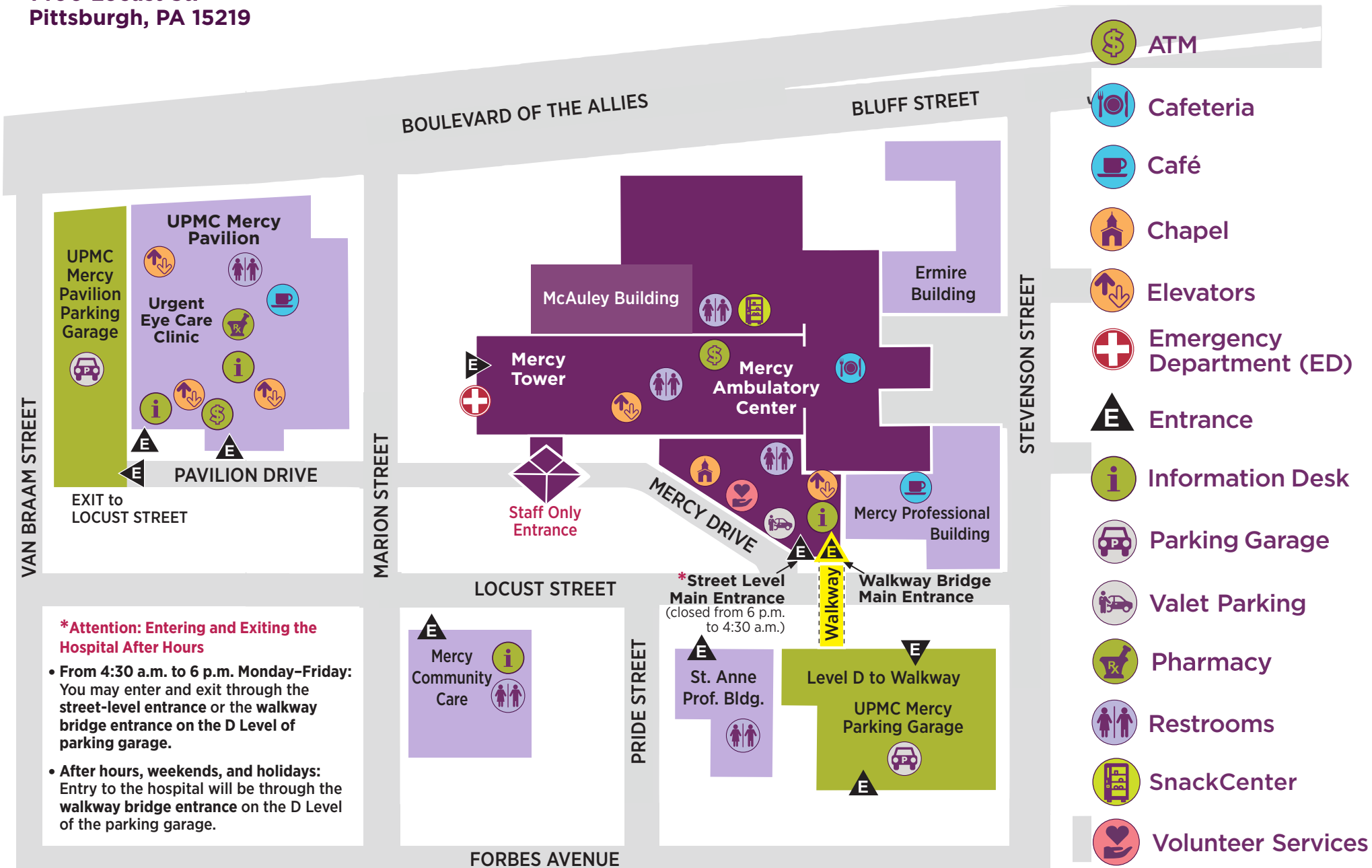

Parking

Valet Parking

Valet parking is available upon request at the street level main entrance (UPMC Mercy Ambulatory Center Entrance). Please see the parking attendants on duty.

UPMC Mercy Parking Garage

UPMC Mercy has an indoor parking garage located across the street from the hospital. The main garage entrance is on Locust Street, with an additional entrance on Forbes Avenue.

UPMC Mercy Pavilion Parking Garage

The UPMC Mercy Pavilion has an indoor parking garage next to it. The Main Entrance is located on Pavilion Drive, off of Marion Street. The entrance on Van Braam Street is for staff only.

Metered Parking

Limited metered parking is available on Stevenson Street and on Forbes Avenue.

Electric Vehicles (EV) Charging Stations

UPMC Mercy Garage: There are 2 charging ports reserved for electric cars on the ground level. Fees apply for the use of the charging stations.

UPMC Mercy Pavilion Garage: There are 8 charging ports reserved for electric cars on levels 4, 5, 6, and 8. Fees apply for the use of the charging stations.

Public Transportation

Amenities and Services

ATM

There is a PNC® ATM located on the 2nd floor of the main hospital near the cafeteria.

Cafeteria

The cafeteria is located on the 2nd floor of the hospital near the yellow elevators.

The 1847 Café

The 1847 Café is located on the ground floor of the hospital, across from the parking garage.

UPMC Mercy SnackCenter

The UPMC Mercy SnackCenter is located on the 2nd floor of the hospital, next to the cafeteria entrance. It is cashless and accepts credit and debit cards only. It is open 24/7.

The Uptown Café

The Uptown Café is located on the 1st floor of the UPMC Mercy Pavilion.



Chapel and Spiritual Care

As a faith-based hospital, we offer Spiritual Care to meet the needs of all persons of faith. The Holy Family Chapel is located on the 1st floor of the hospital and is open for meditation and prayer 24/7.
