Did you know that you can get your prescriptions filled before you leave the hospital? When you're ready to go home, we don't want you to have to make an extra stop at a pharmacy. UPMC Mercy Health Center Pharmacy will work with your hospital health care team to fill your new prescriptions before you leave. These prescriptions can be delivered to your room for convenience.

When is the pharmacy open?

The pharmacy is open from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Who can use this pharmacy?

All patients who are leaving the hospital or hospital clinics can use this service.

How do I get my prescriptions refilled?

If your prescription medicines from your hospital stay include refills, you may take your prescription container to any pharmacy you choose. The pharmacist will call us for your prescription transfer.

Mercy Health Center Pharmacy accepts most major prescription plans. Cash, check, or credit card is accepted for co-pay or cash prescriptions.
