Patient Characteristics

With UPMC Mercy having 3 specialty units, a high percentage of patients are admitted with diagnoses related to Stroke, Brain Injury and Spinal Cord Injury - making up 86% of the patient population.

Our programs accept more medically complex patients compared to other programs in the nation. Our goal is to improve our patient's quality of life and functional independence.

UPMC Mercy has had a 3% increase in patients returning to a community setting from 2022 and a 9% decrease in discharges to skilled nursing facilities.



OUTCOME MEASURES

Our main focus is on the health and safety of our patients, aiming for their successful return to the community. We assess how well our patients are improving in their daily activities and mobility, compared to the expected improvement calculated by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).
