Courtesy

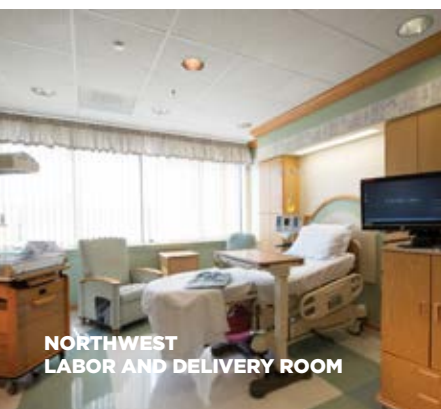
We expect our team to provide care with the utmost courtesy and be respectful of the privacy and dignity of our patients and fellow team members.

Our Signature Services

Behavioral Health

Our Behavioral Health Services division is made up of two programs: Adult Acute and Extended Acute Care. We work with patients to achieve their optimal level of functioning through the use of group therapy, individual counseling, medication management, and diagnosis education. The Behavioral Health Services division uses an integrated approach to care that includes many services throughout the hospital such as occupational therapy, physical therapy, and nutritional services.

Primary and Specialty Care

At UPMC Northwest, our focus is the overall health and wellness of the communities we serve. Area residents are encouraged to coordinate their care - from basic health and preventative medicine to specialty care and inpatient services - with a primary care physician (PCP). UPMC Northwest has 12 PCPs and 31 specialty physicians throughout Venango and Clarion County. Our primary care doctors serve as the gateway to advanced care by UPMC's nationally ranked surgeons, specialists, and health centers.

Orthopaedics and Sports Medicine

UPMC Northwest provides a complete range of orthopaedic services including total joint replacements and fracture care, as well as treatment for injuries to the spine, legs, arms, hands, elbows, shoulders, and neck. We strive to

ensure that communication regarding the needs of athletes takes place among doctors, physician assistants, parents, coaches, and athletic trainers in a timely, efficient manner.

General Surgery

The board-certified general surgeons at UPMC Northwest specialize in a variety of procedures to treat numerous diseases and conditions. Consultations are offered at offices located in Franklin, Titusville, and Clarion. Surgeries and procedures performed at UPMC Northwest include breast, colon and rectal, endoscopy (upper and lower), gallbladder, hemorrhoid, hernia repair, and intestinal.

Cardiovascular Care

From routine diagnostic testing to advanced imaging, catheterization procedures, vascular and endovascular surgery, and cardiac rehabilitation services, UPMC Heart and Vascular Institute-Northwest offers a comprehensive network of cardiovascular services delivered by expert UPMC cardiologists and vascular surgeons.

Telemedicine

The UPMC Teleconsult Center at UPMC Northwest connects patients in our area directly to UPMC specialists in Pittsburgh or in Erie. Using HIPAA-secure video conferencing equipment in a patient exam room, dedicated clinical staff guide live video patient visits. The UPMC Teleconsult

Center gives patients unparalleled, on-demand access to expert specialty care while avoiding the time and expense of long-distance travel.

Women's Health

Family Birthing Center

UPMC Northwest's Family Birthing Center is an all-inclusive, family-centered maternity unit featuring 3 labor and delivery rooms, 12 newborn nursery beds, 3 intermediate care nursery beds, and a cesarean section suite. The center's nurses are required to have neonatal resuscitation certification and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS). Prenatal and postnatal education classes are offered covering topics from infant care to breastfeeding, and 24-hour epidural placement is available.

Magee Specialty Services

In collaboration with the nationally recognized Magee-Womens Hospital of UPMC, UPMC Northwest offers the region's most comprehensive women's services and access to physician specialists unmatched by any other provider in the area. Magee-Womens Specialty Services at UPMC Northwest provides doctors and their patients with access to advanced obstetric and gynecologic care, with office locations in Clarion, Franklin, and Titusville.
