

Summer Nurse Internship Program

The SNI Program is a 10-week (May-July), paid summer internship for student nurses who have completed their junior year of a BSN program or first year of an ASN program. You'll work 36-40 hours a week on a unit in one of a variety of clinical settings.

The SNI Program gives you a strong foundation to build your future as a registered nurse by allowing you to:

- Provide direct patient care, receive one-on-one guidance from a trained preceptor, and build your confidence as a future nurse.
- Develop essential skills with a focus on leadership, patient safety, and professional development through hands-on training and supplemental education sessions.
- Take advantage of various shadowing and nursing immersion experiences to find what you enjoy most.
- Establish relationships with UPMC Northwest nursing leaders and recruiters.
- Take part in our VIP early GN recruitment process, getting a leg-up on exploring and securing your ideal GN role before the end of the program.

- Applications Open: August 15 to March 15*
