

### **Driving Directions**

Note: The UPMC Presbyterian campus is under construction through 2026. Please visit **UPMC.com/Presbyterian** for the latest road closures and traffic flows.

#### From the North

- Take I-79 South to Exit 72 (I-279 South), 2 miles south of Wexford/Route 910.
- Near downtown Pittsburgh, take Exit 2A to I-579.
- Follow the signs to Monroeville.
- The road forks in about 2 miles. Take the left fork to Forbes Avenue/Oakland (do not exit onto I-376 East).
- Stay in the right lane and take the Forbes Avenue ramp.
- Exit onto Forbes Avenue, a one-way street.
- Turn left onto McKee Place.
- Turn right onto Victoria Street.
- Turn left onto Lothrop Street.

#### From the South

- Take I-79 North to Exit 59A (I-279).
- Follow I-376 East through the Fort Pitt Tunnel and continue to I-376 East (sign reads Monroeville).
- Follow I-376 East and take Exit 72A (Forbes Avenue/Oakland).
- Exit onto Forbes Avenue, a one-way street.
- Turn left onto McKee Place.
- Turn right onto Victoria Street.
- Turn left onto Lothrop Street.

### **Parking**

When arriving at the hospital during evening and night hours, park in this garage:

If you are arriving at the hospital after hours, please enter through the Emergency Department.

#### From the East

- Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 57 (Pittsburgh/Monroeville) to I-376 West.
- From I-376 West, take Exit 73B (Oakland/Bates Street).
- Follow Bates Street to the 1st stoplight and turn left onto Boulevard of the Allies.
- At the 1st stoplight on Boulevard of the Allies, turn right onto Halket Street.
- Follow Halket Street past UPMC Magee-Womens Hospital (on the left).
- Continue to the 1st stoplight and turn right onto Forbes Avenue, a one-way street.
- Turn left onto McKee Place.
- Turn right onto Victoria Street.
- Turn left onto Lothrop Street.

#### From the West

- From the Pennsylvania Turnpike, take Exit 10 for I-376 East (Old Route 60 South).
- Follow I-376 past the Pittsburgh International Airport through the Fort Pitt Tunnel, toward Monroeville (I-376 East).
- Continue on I-376 East and take Exit 72A (Forbes Avenue/Oakland).
- Exit onto Forbes Avenue, a one-way street.
- Turn left onto McKee Place.
- Turn right onto Victoria Street.
- Turn left onto Lothrop Street.

# **Dining**

#### Cafeteria

Located on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor. Open from 6:30 a.m. to 12 a.m. daily.

#### Market C at UPMC Presbyterian

Located on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor outside of the cafeteria. Open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

#### Starbucks®

Located on the 1st floor near the gift shop. Open Monday through Friday 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.; Saturday and Sunday 6 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Located on the 1st floor lobby of the Biomedical Science Tower.
