

UPMC Oakland Campus Master Plan

The UPMC Oakland campus, comprised of UPMC Presbyterian, UPMC Montefiore, Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic of UPMC and many outpatient and office buildings, is committed to providing high-quality, comprehensive healthcare to the residents of our community. We are building on that commitment by proposing a number of expansions and projects that will allow for a higher level of patient care and convenience. Our Master Plan, which is required by the City of Pittsburgh, incorporates many projects, including:

- Removal of the old Children's Hospital building.
- New Inpatient Tower constructed on the site where the old Children's Hospital currently stands and part of what is now green space near Fifth Avenue.
- Construction of additional parking above the current Montefiore parking garage.
- Expansion of patient care units at the Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic.
- Addition of a bus terminal in front of the new inpatient tower.

Although these projects are proposed, no plans have been finalized.
