- 4.8% Neurological Conditions (17 cases)
- 4.3% Pulmonary (15 cases)
- 6.3% Traumatic Brain Injury (22 cases)
- 2.3% Non-traumatic spinal cord (8 cases)
- 3.7% Replacement of Lower Extremity (13 cases)


