CLINICAL PROGRAMS



HEART AND VASCULAR CARE

The nationally recognized UPMC Heart and Vascular Institute provides comprehensive cardiovascular care while advancing the field of cardiovascular medicine and offering hundreds of clinical trials.

- More than 200 cardiologists, surgeons, and researchers, 60 locations, and seven open-heart programs.
- Team approach includes specialists in inherited cardiac diseases, heart valve disease, advanced heart failure, electrophysiology, vascular and cardiac surgery, and more.
- Artificial heart program, using ventricular assist devices (VADs), one of the most active in the U.S., offering patients a bridge to heart transplantation or, in some cases, the opportunity to heal without needing a transplant.
- More than 1,500 transcatheter aortic valve replacements.

LUNG CARE

The UPMC Comprehensive Lung Center is a multidisciplinary program with specialists in pulmonary medicine, offering treatment for conditions including pulmonary hypertension, asthma, allergic disorders, COPD and emphysema, cystic fibrosis, sleep medicine, and interstitial lung disease.

- Services include experimental therapies and timely access to lung transplants.
- Comprehensive Pulmonary Hypertension Program offers full range of treatment options, from cutting-edge therapies to our world-renowned lung transplant program.
- No hospital in western Pennsylvania has more expertise in asthma, COPD, interstitial lung disease, lung transplant, and cystic fibrosis.





ORGAN TRANSPLANT

Founded under the leadership of Thomas E. Starzl, MD, a pioneer in transplant medicine, UPMC has been a leader in organ transplantation for more than 40 years and continues to innovate in this complex field.

- More than 20,000 adult and pediatric organ transplant surgeries, including liver, kidney, pancreas, intestinal, heart, heart/lung, double-lung, single-lung, and multiple-organ transplants.
- The nation's first beating heart transplant, the world's first heart-liver transplant, and the world's first heart-liver-kidney transplant.
- More than 1,000 combined pediatric and adult living-donor liver transplants, the most performed in the U.S.
- The first pediatric transplant program in the U.S. (at UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh).
- More than 2,400 lung transplants.

CANCER CARE

UPMC Hillman Cancer Center delivers innovative cancer care at 80 locations in the United States, Ireland, Italy, and Croatia. UPMC Hillman is one of only 57 National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Centers—a distinction that is earned through excellence in research across multiple branches of science and ongoing community education and outreach activities—and has been NCI designated since 1990.

- Leader in cancer immunotherapeutics, using the body's own defenses to fight cancer.
- The first center in western Pennsylvania to offer chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T-cell therapy, with more than 340 FDA-approved CAR T-cell therapy treatments delivered since 2018.

VISION CARE

The UPMC Vision Institute leverages our global leadership in health care and scientific research, harnessing the expertise of physicians, scientists, engineers, and allied experts to deliver comprehensive care across a range of specialties in ophthalmology.

- Based at UPMC Mercy Pavilion, a state-of-the-art facility that includes a life skills apartment, rooftop sensory garden, and street simulation lab to help patients with vision loss learn to navigate the world independently.
- Demonstrated the first case of vision restoration in a human in 2021 in collaboration with an international team.
- 22 research laboratories dedicated to exploring the visual systems.
- Pioneering biotherapies and employing therapeutic proteins, gene supplementation, correction, and editing, cell therapies, and optogenetics, which use gene therapy to reprogram retina cells, to prevent vision loss and restore sight.

NEUROLOGY AND NEUROSURGERY

The UPMC Neurological Institute combines the expertise of skilled neurologists and neurosurgeons. Home to the largest academic neurosurgery department in the U.S., with national and international recognition for minimally invasive neurosurgery and stroke research and treatment, our physicians are innovators in treating complex, life-threatening brain and spine conditions using highly advanced procedures.

- World leaders in minimally invasive neurosurgery.
- Endoscopic Endonasal Approach (EEA) for hard-to-reach skull-based tumors allows surgeons to operate directly through the nose without facial incisions that cause disfigurement.
- More than 35 years of experience using Gamma Knife® radiosurgery, which UPMC introduced to North America in 1987.
- Performed the first microvascular decompression, now the standard of care for severe cranial nerve disorders.
- Level 4 Epilepsy Center, the highest designation awarded by the National Association of Epilepsy Centers.
- Nationally recognized as a Center for Advanced Research by the American Parkinson Disease Association—one of only eight in the country.
- In collaboration with the University of Pittsburgh Alzheimer's Disease Research Center, integrating leading-edge science caring for patients with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, and frontotemporal disorders.

SERVICES FOR PATIENTS TRAVELING TO PITTSBURGH

Patients travel to UPMC from across the country, and around the world – and UPMC offers a dedicated medical concierge service, free of charge, to help patients and their caregivers navigate the process of seeking care away from home.

 - > Dietary and religious support and coordination with clinical teams.
 - > Assisting with navigation to appointments.
