

## FOR YOUR INFORMATION PHOTOGRAPHY

Photography is necessary during your office visits.

Procedures covered by insurance require that photos be submitted to your insurance carrier for approval of the procedure. We will ask that all undergarments and jewelry be removed for the photograph. These photos require multiple views from several angles.

Faces are never photographed unless facial surgery is planned.

Photographs are taken again on the day of surgery or when the surgeon draws the markings on you for your procedure.

Post-operative photos are taken again usually after 2 months, but may be taken sooner or later.

All photos are confidential and stay in your chart. We understand that this can be an uncomfortable experience for you, and would like you to know that these photos are taken in a private setting and take only a few minutes. A nurse or chaperone is usually present for the photographs.
