More than 60,000 young children end up in emergency rooms every year because they got into medicines while their parent or caregiver was not looking.

Keep your
child safe.

- Store cleaning supplies and medications in a locked cabinet UP & AWAY, where kids can't see or reach them.
- Keep cleaning supplies and medications in original containers.
- Use child-resistant packaging—But Remember—Nothing is Child Proof!!
- Read the label! Follow directions for safe use of cleaning supplies. DO NOT leave open containers unattended!
- DO NOT mix cleaning supplies! This can cause the release of dangerous gases.

Poison Look Alikes:

Poisons can look like food or drink. Teach children to ask an adult before eating or drinking anything. Remember, young children can't read labels, and many products around the home look like candy or something tasty to drink.
