In partnership with the UPMC Rehabilitation Institute and the UPMC Heart and Vascular Institute, many locations offer Transitional Care Units (TRUs) designed to support the short-term skilled patients discharging from hospitals but not ready for home. The TRUs offer specialized care with the majority of patients transitioning to home. 


