

3.4 times

Benzodiazepine-related deaths increased

5 times

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Benzodiazepines & Opioids



Benzodiazepines and opioids are

controlled substances



In order to give you medicine, your pharmacy requires your health care provider to write a

prescription



Hospital policy requires your health care provider to write you a new prescription every

30 days



If your health care provider breaks the law, they can lose their license or get

iail time



Individuals addicted to opioids are

40 times more likely to become addicted to heroin



If you take both benzodiazepines and opioids, you are

61% more likely to fatally overdose
