
MitraClip® Therapy at UPMC Pinnacle



MitraClip is a procedure for individuals who have a progressive heart condition called mitral regurgitation, which occurs when the mitral valve allows a backflow of blood into the heart's left atrium.

UPMC Pinnacle Harrisburg was the first hospital in Pennsylvania to perform the catheter-based mitral valve repair with the MitraClip following the device's approval by the Food & Drug Administration (FDA). This minimally invasive procedure is ideal for patients who are not healthy enough for the more invasive standard treatment which requires open heart (chest-cracking) surgery. Medication treatments for these patients only manage the symptoms and do not stop the progression of mitral valve regurgitation.

How MitraClip Works:

- The device is implanted using a minimally invasive procedure performed through a small incision in the groin.
- The MitraClip is a small device, which clips the leaflets of the mitral valve together to prevent blood from flowing backwards through the valve.
- It is carried to the heart inside a catheter and once implanted allows the heart to pump more efficiently.
