Pediatric versus Adult Testing Administration

Please understand that the tests are administered differently. The pediatric test is administered on a tablet with a parent present in the room. The Adult test is administered in a classroom on a laptop.

We can't administer both tests at the same time due to how the tests are administered.

Test Administration

- 1 parent/guardian must be present for testing for **Pediatric Testing ages 5-9**
- 1 parent/guardian will be admitted into the testing area for **kids ages 10-11**

Special Accommodations

If your child requires special accommodations for testing (ex. quiet testing room, instructor to read and explain instructions) please contact Rob Dingle at 412-432-3635. We will do our best, within reason, to meet the needs of your child.

Passport ID

Every participant will be given a 12-digit code upon completion of their baseline test. This is also included in the post-test confirmation email. The Passport ID allows all medical providers who utilize the ImpACT test to gain access to one's baseline. Please note, most pediatricians do NOT utilize the pediatric version of the ImpACT test.
